This is the confirmation that the registered competitors are approved to perform for your country/society. The final decision will be made after the deadline according to the Allocation System

Here some existing ideas and experiences

GENI'S "CLAUSTRO"

The Spanish association **GENI** is in charge of holding an annual work meeting called "**Claustro**". They are already in their twelfth edition with unprecedented success. Its main characteristics are:

- It is focused on the stage categories in the FISM contests
- They work in an isolated country house with little contact with the outside world for 5 intense days, with almost 12 hours a day of work
- A maximum of 14 acts are worked in two shifts of one hour
- Apart from the components that present their acts, there is a group of five/six magicians called "Masters" who have a brilliant CV and help to polish the presented acts.
- Claustro works under the motto of the three musketeers: "One for all and all for one"
- Card tricks (card magic) are strictly prohibited (even during break times)
- In the middle of the Claustro, there is an outing to a theater to present a gala to the public and thus raise funds by achieving almost a self-financing of the project (catering, accommodation, travel, infrastructure, etc.)
- The participants are 50% Spanish, and the others are from different European countries.

In these twelve years, more than 150 artists from all over Europe and even from other continents have participated and many of them have won prizes in national competitions, in FISM ECM and FISM WCM championships.



CMI COLLEGE

CMI College/ItaTeam was founded in 2008 as an expression of the most important and long-lived association of Italian Magicians (Club Magico Italiano founded in 1952) with the aim of selecting a group of artists representing Italian Magic in FISM Competition, International Galas, and competitions, thus forming Italian National Team of Magicians that can promote the growth and diffusion of Magical Art in Italy, develop the artistic value and the recognizability of Italian Magic in the world, create opportunities for comparison among Italian talents.

The selected participants are divided into Masters (magicians who have won a prize in a national or international competition or have participated in galas in qualified magical events) and Cadets (talented magicians who have not yet participated in galas or competitions but who are creating a stage number or close-up competition)

The activities of the CMI College take place throughout Italy with

- Focus group
- Public exhibition
- Group or individual meetings with the other members of the College
- Activities at the local offices of the CMI or at other clubs

Since 2012 all Italian FISM member Associations work together on this project helping to select and prepare magicians for the Italian Team
